

## Trinity Stitch Pattern

## Also known as Cluster Stitch or Bramble Stitch



The pattern is a multiple of 4 stitches done over 4 rows. Instructions for knitting flat:

Row 1: (Right side) - Purl

Row 2: \*(K1, P1, K1) all in same stitch, P3tog. Repeat from \* across.

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: \*P3tog, (K1, P1, K1) all in the same stitch. Repeat from \* across.

Repeat these 4 rows for the desired length of your fabric.

## Instructions for knitting circular:

Pattern is 4 stitches done over 4 rows – cast on even number of stitches divisible by 4

Row 1: Purl all stitches

Row 2: (P1,K1,P1 all in same stitch), K3tog - repeat across the round

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K3tog, (P1,K1,P1 all in same stitch) - repeat across the round
